

## UNICEF's Mission and Innovation Process

- UNICEF's mission of fulfilling the needs and rights of children drives the whole process.
- UNICEF has to initiate, manage and monitor the process from need identification to handover and rights fulfillment.
- UNICEF makes innovations available to children by making potentially effective, but high risk and costly commodities and interventions much more effective, simple, accessible and affordable.

## Multiple-Partnership in Innovation Process

- Different partners will be involved at different stages. Typically in following processes
  - Local & International NGOs, Development institutions (identification, piloting)
  - Like minded flexible donors, Government ministries (packaging, institutionalization)
  - Big donors, IFIs (scaling up)
  - Local Government, Community (all process)
  - Corporate and Private Sector (handing over)
  - Households. (handing over)

## Resource Needs for Innovation Process

- Different types and sizes of resources will be used in different stages:
  - Identification: Small RR
  - Piloting: Medium RR & Soft OR
  - Packaging: Medium RR & Soft OR
  - Institutionalization: Medium size OR
  - Scaling up: Big OR, big and specific OR, Loans from development bank,
  - Handover: Locally controlled funds, Corporate partnership, community cost sharing, and household self financing.
